Create a safe place in your home for your dog to stay during the fireworks. Put their bed there, water, toys, and turn on music or a television as white noise.

Watch what your dog eats. Good intentions can go bad when giving too much human food as treats. Dogs when unattended might get into something they shouldn't.

Keep your dog inside during the fireworks. July 5th is one of the busiest days at animal shelters because so many dogs become disoriented and get lost.

Have your dog's collar and ID tags on. If your dog is microchipped, be sure the tracking is up to date.
